### **BLACKFOOT HERITAGE SIXTH GRADE STUDENT BUS STOP INDEX INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Locate your elementary zone A.M. bus stop file and open it.
2. Locate the closest stop to your home.
3. Note the time for the A.M. pick-up. Please have your student arrive no less than 5 minutes early to the bus stop.
4. Open the BHSB Shuttle Information link. Locate your elementary school and note the RT numbers for their BHSB Shuttles. (E.g. Ridge Crest to BHSB in the morning is Rt 12).
5. For the afternoon, all BHSB students are bused to their home elementary school. They need to catch the corresponding shuttle from BHSB when they are released. The shuttles have signs in their windows indicating which elementary school they will travel to. For more information on this, please see the BHSB Shuttle Information link.
6. Locate and open your elementary zone P.M. bus stop file.
7. Locate the closest stop to your home. **Our stops are not the exact same in the morning and the afternoon!!!** Please ensure that your student understands what bus they are to get on after school.
8. Provide your student with their complete take home information (bus route number and stop address/description).

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE!**

All BHSB students requiring bus transportation after school, load onto shuttle buses that park in front of BHSB after school. **STUDENTS MUST RIDE THE SHUTTLE! IF STUDENTS WALK BETWEEN SCHOOLS, THEY WILL BE DENIED SERVICE FOR THE DAY.** It is District Policy for the safety of students and staff that students are required to utilize the shuttles after school.

**Please note that a bus pass is only necessary if your student is riding a different bus than their usual take-home bus, or they are brand new to the district.**
